- Personal plastic bags for dirty clothes. If you plan on washing some items during the week, bring travel size laundry soap. You can wash in buckets and dry on deck with clothes pins. (usually the charter boat will have them)
- Sailing gloves (if you want to participate in sailing)
- Boat shoes. (flip flops are ok at anchor and ashore but are unacceptable underway).
- Dinghy-landing shoes or water shoes are great.
- Thin or microfiber quick dry beach towel. Boat towels are small and not allowed on the beach as they bring sand back to the boat.
- Light rain jacket or wind breaker is fine.
- Warm-weather clothing (as needed). Temps mid 70's
- Daily-wear clothes for warm/cool weather. Light layers.
- Dressy clothes not necessary.
- Specialty foods that you must have (prunes, ginger, gourmet food, tea etc) Please bring personal supply of items you must have.
- Pack a bathing suit, meds and items you may need in your carry on, in case your luggage gets lost.
- Good walking shoes. Sandals with support are great!
- Travel-sized toiletries and hygiene products
- Insect repellent & OTC pain relievers/ointments (motion sickness)
- AUX cable for playing music through your device. Most boats have Bluetooth for your favorite music!
- 12V to USB power adapter for charging mobile devices
- Power Adapter for electric if you need for tablets, computer.
- If you have a CPAP machine, please bring the battery supply pack.
- Neck wallet for valuables/passport
- Electrolyte tablets only drink bottled water. You still may get a case of diarrhea. Be prepared!
- If you are on any medications, please bring enough supply for the week. Must be labeled or in original container.
- **DON'T OVERPACK. YOU WON'T WEAR ALL THE CLOTHES YOU BRING!**

SEASICKNESS

If you are at all worried about seasickness, as a preventative, you can start taking a product called bonine about 4 days before we leave and continue to take throughout the charter. It's widely available in places like Walmart or drug stores. (if you're on medication, make sure to check with your doctor before using). You can also bring Dramamine and take before sailing.

DON'T FORGET!

Please ensure you bring hard copies and Images stored on your phone of the following:

- Passport (for each guest)
- Plane Boarding Tickets
- Vaccination Card

Please use soft sided bags/duffels
